**Context/  
Occasion**

**Time:**  
Describe what's special about this moment in time (e.g., holiday, historical event, or once-in-a-lifetime opportunity)

**Place:**  
Describe what makes the location unique (e.g., a private home, public space, natural setting, city, or nation)

**Social Expectations:**  
Describe the behavior people consider appropriate for this occasion (e.g., rules and manners)

**The Language of Kairos:**  
List any words or phrases in the text that suggest the importance of time

**Quickwrite:** How would you describe the kairos of this text? Why are time, place, and social expectations important to the writer's argument? Do you think the writer has chosen the best opportunity to make his or her argument?
